SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum (PM) 2003-02; Wear of Shoulder Cords by Cadets in Nebraska Wing

1. The following Shoulder cords (fourrageres, lanyards, augulittes etc.) may be worn only at Nebraska Wing activates except for summer encampments. As per CAPM 39-1, not more than one fourrageres or lanyard will be worn at one time, and it will be worn on the left shoulder.
2. A white shoulder cord is authorized for cadets while they are performing in a Color Guard. A silver shoulder cord is authorized for cadets while performing in an Honor Guard. Please refer to PM 2003-01 for appropriate Honor Guard activities.
3. The winners of the Nebraska Wing Color Guard Competition may wear a white and silver braided shoulder cord until the next competition or one year, which ever comes first.
4. The Nebraska Wing Cadet(s) of the Year may wear a red and white shoulder cord for a period of one year, or the next Cadet of the Year is announced, which ever comes first.
5. With approval from the Director of Cadet Programs, a gold and blue braided shoulder cord is authorized for those cadets currently earning a 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
6. With approval from the Director of Cadet Programs, Cadets that have earned a unit award such as Cadet of the Year, Cadet of the Quarter, or Cadet of the Month may wear a blue and white braided shoulder cord.
